

CONSENT TO PUBLISH AND COPYRIGHT AGREEMENT

It is required that the authors of articles in Kyushu Journal of Mathematics provide a formal written Consent to Publish. The signed Consent to Publish gives the Publisher permission of the Author to publish the Work. The signed Transfer of Copyright empowers the Publisher to protect the Work against unauthorized use, and also covers dissemination of the Work by secondary information sources such as abstracting, reviewing and indexing.
